Dr. David F. Pyke is professor of operations and supply chain management at the University of San Diego School of Business. He was dean of the business school from 2008 until 2015. Formerly, he was professor of operations management and associate dean at the Tuck School of Business Administration at Dartmouth College. He obtained his BA from Haverford College, MBA from Drexel University, and his MA and Ph.D. from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. His research and consulting have focused on inventory management, production planning and scheduling, blockchain, risk management, and operations and supply chain strategy. His book, "Inventory and Production Management in Supply Chains," co-authored with E. A. Silver and D. Thomas (fourth edition, CRC Press, 2017), is used in numerous master's and Ph.D. programs worldwide. He is a frequent faculty at executive programs worldwide and has consulted with many large and small companies.
