The program's multidisciplinary teams use convergence research fundamentals and innovation processes to stimulate innovative idea-sharing and develop sustainable solutions.

Mathew is a technical writer who has worked on building mechanical codes and policies for ecological sanitation since 2010. He led the writing of the Recode Model Code, IAPMO/ANSI WE Stand chapter on composting and urine-diverting toilets, and the proposed International Plumbing Code (IPC) appendix on urine diversion, which recently received committee approval for the 2026 IPC.
