



I Resolve to Save Water in 2015!

I will celebrate the New Year by taking the pledge at www.epa.gov/watersense/pledge and checking off one or more simple step each month to save water for myself, my family, and future generations.

January 2015

- I'm making it official! I [pledge to save water](#) inside, outdoors, and at work with a little "water sense."
- Before shopping for WaterSense labeled products, I will look for [rebates](#).



February 2015

- I will flush with a [WaterSense labeled toilet](#) to score super savings for Team Water during Super Bowl halftime.
- I will plan a romantic getaway or spring trip to a hotel that saves water by booking with a [WaterSense H₂Otel Challenge participant](#).



March 2015

- After setting the clocks for Daylight Saving Time, I will spring forward to water savings by checking my irrigation control settings, if I have an automatic watering system.
- To celebrate [Fix a Leak Week](#) March 16 through 22, 2015, I will check toilets for leaks using a drop of food coloring in the tank. If any color shows up in the bowl after 15 minutes before I flush, we have a leak. A new flapper will likely be the easy fix!



April 2015

- April showers bring May flowers—I will shape up the yard by browsing WaterSense's [Water-Smart Landscape Photo Gallery](#) and planting [low water-using, native plants](#).
- I will celebrate Earth Day on April 22 with these [simple steps to save water](#).



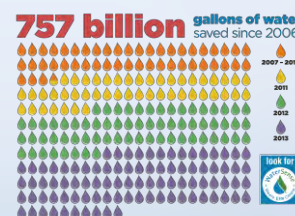
May 2015

- I will aerate soil to improve water flow to root zones and reduce runoff.



June 2015

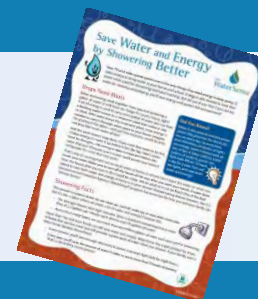
August 2015
